Questions for Personal and Family Devotions

1. Is salvation God's accomplishment or your achievement?
2. What happens first: Does man believe first then he is born again? Or was he born again first then he believes?
3. Is there injustice on God's part? Is God unfair?
4. Do you think that God chose you individually to be saved before he created the world?
5. Was your election based on the fact that God knew you would believe in Christ, or was it "unconditional election", not based on anything that God foresaw in you that made you worthy of his love?
