WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?

Questions for Personal and Family Devotions

- 1. What can we learn from the alternation of "minor" and "major" keys in the four sections of verse 1-11?
- 2. Was Jesus truly forsaken by God? Share some ways He <u>was</u> forsaken and some ways He <u>was not</u> forsaken.
- 3. What does v1 reveal is Jesus' priority? Does your life show your relationship to <u>God</u> is your greatest concern?
- 4. Share some ways Psalm 22 teaches us how we should respond to our trying circumstances. What can we preach to ourselves in such times (vv. 3-5, 9-11)? If you are a believer, will God ever forsake you? How do you know?
