The Westminster Shorter Catechism Q/A 35

Scripture: Romans 6:1-14

1. Sanctification's Producer – *Sanctification is the work of God's free grace*
2. Sanctification's Process – *We are renewed in the whole person after the image of God*
3. Sanctification's Progress – *We are enabled more and more to die to sin and live to righteousness*
