3. What does "walking in love," look like in your marriage, family, workplace, school, or church?
4. How does Christ's sacrificial love challenge the way you think about serving others?
5. Why is it important to remember that good works are the fruit of salvation rather than the cause of salvation?
6. Are you trying to live like a child in order to earn your Father's love, or are you living like a child because you already have your Father's love in Christ?
