1. Repentance - *I acknowledged my sin to you*
2. Forgiveness - *Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven*
3. Rejoicing - *Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, O righteous*

3. Has the Word been implanted in you? Has it saved your soul?
4. How has God's Word acted like a mirror in your life by revealing sinful thoughts, tendencies, words, or actions?
5. How can you tell if you are hearing God's Word without actively doing God's Word?
